- Location: 7005 Old Birmingham Hwy, Tuscaloosa, AL 35404
- Distance from Downtown Tuscaloosa: 10-minute drive
- Trail distance: 4 Trails - 11.7 total miles

- Location: Lake Harris Rd, Tuscaloosa, AL 35406
- Distance from Downtown Tuscaloosa: 25-minute drive
- Trail distance: 1.4 miles

LAKE NICOL

- Location: Lake Nicol Rd, Tuscaloosa, AL 35406
- Distance from Downtown Tuscaloosa: 20-minute drive
- Trail distance: 4 Trails - 3.3 total miles

- Distance from Downtown Tuscaloosa: 10-minute drive
